What is Hui Mālama O Ke Kai?

Hui Mālama O Ke Kai Keiki Program is a Waimanalo community-based afterschool program for students in the 5th-6th grades. The curriculum and program are focused in Native Hawaiian values and on the traditions of our community to reinforce the importance of place in the identity of our students. Students will become aware of their environment and the cultural and historical significance of various *wahi pana*, or noted areas. 'Ohana of students are encouraged to participate in 'ohana strengthening activities held on weekends and evenings.

When?

The Hui Mālama O Ke Kai after-school Keiki Program runs from October 13, 2014 – June 2, 2014. The after-school program is provided everyday after school until 6:00pm. **DAILY ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY.**

Who may apply?

Students in grades 5 & 6 who reside in the Waimānalo community may apply.

How does one apply?

Parents must complete and sign the Student Interest Form and submit it to their child's teacher (at Pope or Waimānalo School) or email it to the Keiki Program Specialist (tiare@huimalamaokekai.org) by **August 22nd, 2014.**

Parents of students considered for the program will be contacted to make a follow-up registration appointment in the month of September.

Preference Policy

Hui Mālama O Ke Kai is a Waimānalo community-based program whose mission is to serve the youth and families of Waimānalo. Accordingly, applicants who are residents of Waimānalo will be given first consideration.

In order to provide a continuation of services, Hui Mālama O Ke Kai gives preference to students who were enrolled in the program the previous year. Recommendations from teachers and school counselors are also considered. Applications are reviewed on a first come, first served basis.
